The resulting The Wildlife Photographer of the Year is arranged by category and copies of each photograph are made available to agents around the world. The Australian Museum is the tour organiser in Australia.
CONTENT	Exhibition consists of about 106 framed images and text. Photographs and text are provided by the Organiser, NHM London. The Australian Museum produces the Australian tour consisting of framed images incorporating labels; exhibition graphics and section headings.
