	<i>Behind the Lines</i> is an annual cartooning exhibition. It is anticipated that a <i>Behind the Lines</i> exhibition will be developed in 2008 to tour in 2009 as well.

<b>DESCRIPTION</b>	<b><i>Behind the Lines 2007 – The year’s best cartoons</i></b> will bring together the best works of political cartoonists published across Australia in 2007. This will be the tenth annual cartoon exhibition presented by the National Museum of Australia and will cover the major events and personalities of the year. The cartoons will be both amusing and thought provoking, providing a wonderful opportunity to reflect on the year of Australian politics, covering the November election. Previous exhibitions have been highly successful, attracting large crowds in Brisbane, Canberra, Melbourne, Sydney and Perth.
<b>CONTENT</b>	The exhibition will consist of approximately 80 - 100 cartoons. The exhibition will also include an audio visual component with a DVD loop of interviews with leading Australian political cartoonists. The exhibition will consist of a People’s Choice element, including voting panel and slips.
<b>AVAILABLE</b>	On tour from March 2008 – February 2009, the touring schedule is currently full.
