

## TOURING EXHIBITION

<b>TITLE/SUBTITLE</b>	<b>League of Legends</b>
<b>DEVELOPMENT STATUS</b>	Design and fabrication
<b>OTHER PARTIES</b>	National Rugby League
<b>DATE OPEN</b>	7 March 2008 at the National Museum of Australia
<b>SIZE</b>	400 – 450 sq m with the ability to be scaled down to no less than 200 sq m
<b>DESCRIPTION</b>	The National Museum of Australia is developing a travelling exhibition to celebrate the Centenary of Rugby League in 2008. The exhibition will explore the history of the game since its inception in Australia, reviewing the major milestones and events throughout that history.
<b>CONTENT</b>	This exhibition will utilise sports photography, sporting memorabilia and film, sound and video records of games. The RAS Shield, the first Rugby League Shield, is held by the Museum. A targeted acquisition program will be launched to acquire material and identify potential loans. Discussions with the NRL, ARL, NSWRL and QRL have identified a number of significant collections that can be called upon. Through the selection of objects, we can represent a number of clubs and regions across Australia, and address the national spread of Rugby League. Contributions from the relevant state offices and from local clubs would also have the benefit of increasing local interest in the exhibition.
<b>AVAILABLE</b>	On tour from May 2008. Availability from March 2009.
<b>NUMBER OF OBJECTS</b>	Approximately 300
<b>OBJECT MOUNTS</b>	Supplied
<b>EXHIBITION FURNITURE</b>	All exhibition furniture supplied including plinths, graphics, showcases and didactics.
<b>TARGET AUDIENCE</b>	General
<b>EDUCATION MATERIALS</b>	It is anticipated that an education resource kit will be available to venues.
<b>COMMUNITY PROGRAMMES</b>	Advice and support offered for any community programs. The NRL is available for any community based programs
<b>MARKETING MATERIALS</b>	The Museum will provide artwork for use in print advertising and/or posters. Advice on marketing and support for public affairs or media related promotion will be made available if required.
<b>MERCHANDISE</b>	A catalogue will be produced in conjunction with the exhibition. The Museum is in discussion with the NRL concerning other possible merchandise.
<b>SPONSORSHIP</b>	
<b>SIZE FOR FREIGHTING</b>	Furniture 1 semi-trailer, Objects in 1 pantec
<b>SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS</b>	The NMA will provide staff for installation and deinstallation. Host venue to provide 2 – 3 skilled install staff for furniture install/deinstall and Registration/Collection staff to assist with object install/deinstall. Minimum of 8 weeks display preferred.
<b>COST</b>	\$5000 - \$10,000. This will be adjusted on a pro rata basis depending on how much of the exhibition can be displayed in the venue.
