DESCRIPTION	This highly interactive exhibition focuses on the Earth Observing System (EOS) and examines how satellite observations are made and what we can learn about the Earth using space technology. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • There are 14 interactive exhibits and three main themes: Satellites, Orbits and Satellite Technology. • A Virtual Room: experience satellites and their orbits up close and in 3D. • A Google Earth exhibit is also available.
CONTENT	Beyond the atmosphere of Earth circle the satellites of the Earth Observing System (EOS), NASA's primary satellite mission. These remote observers constantly scan our planet - tracking weather, monitoring pollution, creating maps, and gathering information to help predict storms, monitor forest fires and study holes in the ozone layer.
